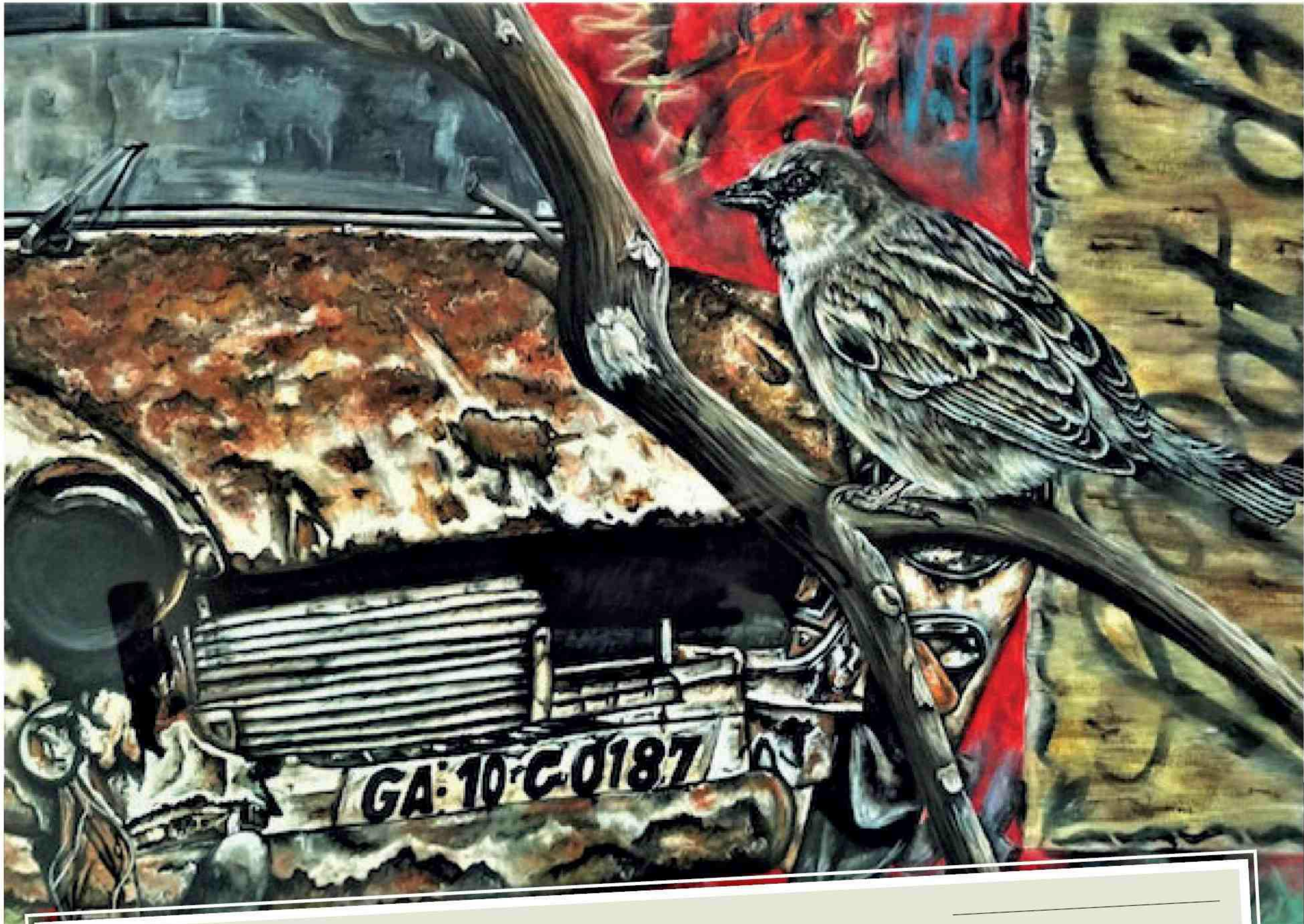


# Colour theory
