About the Artist - Pragya Jain



Pragya Jain is a native of New Delhi where she completed the first twelve years of her schooling at the Modern School, New Delhi. In 2001, India's former president Dr Abdul Kalam awarded her with a Distinction in Arts following the AISSC Exams. Pragya gained admission to the prestigious Delhi College of Art, New Delhi after ranking seventh in the entrance examination process.

Soon after graduating with a BFA in 2005, she had her first public showing in New Delhi.

She spent the next six years building her body of work in the United States which was exhibited in New York City, Amherst, Boston, Dhaka, St. Petersburg and several towns that celebrate art. For the last 12 years Pragya has called Bangalore her home. Her first solo exhibition in the city at Sublime Galleria in 2009 was a complete sell out and helped her gain patronage from of prominent collectors in the United States and India. During Covid years, she worked collectively on a sustainable upcycled Mural which stands 10 feet tall & wide at the Indira Gandhi International Airport, New Delhi. In 2018 she co-founded eco-conscious brand Artychoke with the intention of creating homeware and accessories adorned with her designs. She does multiple shows to support various charities, helping raise funds through her art for the underprivileged through the platform of FICCI, schools that support Autism & other organisations. Her biography has been featured in a prestigious book – Sunflowers - one of 11 artists, authored by Sujata Parashar. Pragya's debut in UAE was at World Art Dubai 2025 and she is working on her onward journey to show her art in India and internationally.

About the Show - Tranquil Balance

A quiet yearning draws me into nature—into its silences, its murmurs, its rhythms that stir something within me. Nature narrates a story of innocence, enveloping us in its unspoken generosity. Is it not the most selfless force, endlessly offering the very elements that sustain our existence?







The auspicious lotus appears gently, its calming palette rendered in delicately shaded threads, resonating with Nandi's steadfast grace and patience.
